

Notice Regarding Medical Fees for Foreign Patients Not Covered by Japan's Public Health Insurance System

To Patients and Their Families

Our hospital's medical resources are supported by the premiums and taxes paid by the people of Japan. We believe that foreign patients should also bear medical expenses on the same basis as Japanese patients.

For patients who are not Japanese nationals and are not enrolled in a valid public health insurance system in Japan (hereinafter referred to as "foreign patients"), medical consultations and treatment generally require more time than usual in order to accurately assess their medical condition and provide appropriate explanations regarding their treatment. In addition, administrative procedures may also be more complex.

In consideration of these additional costs associated with providing medical care to foreign patients, our hospital calculates medical fees based on the following standard.

Fee Calculation Standard

Medical fees are calculated by multiplying the number of points under Japan's Social Health Insurance Medical Fee Schedule by 19 yen per point.

This unit price has been determined in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare, based on the fee-setting standards applicable to designated medical institutions that serve as key facilities for accepting foreign patients.
